Overview

The assistant coach is an important member of the coaching staff. Competent, trained assistant coaches are vital to the success of accomplishing the mission of Castleview Recreational Ministries (CRM). You are an aid to the head coach in teaching the skills and the rules of the game. You are to ensure the safety of the participants and help maintain the policies of the league. In addition to the coach you provide encouragement and support to your players and their parents.

Qualifications

- One who exhibits a genuine love and understanding of the age group he is coaching.
- One who has an enthusiasm for the sport, a sense of humor, exhibits patience, shows kindness, is dependable, loyal, emotionally mature, considerate of others, alert to individual needs, fair, respects authority, and willing to listen.
- One who has knowledge of the fundamental skills of the sport and the rules of the game and is committed to the personal development of the individual over winning.
- One who is able to communicate with his players through demonstration and verbal explanation. He/she should be able to organize, teach and deal with individuals as well as with the group.
- One who is willing to accept the philosophy and policies of CRM.
- One who is committed to accepting his responsibilities as an assistant coach.

Expectations

Work along side the coach, helping and supporting him in any way possible.

He/she should come along side of the coach in incorporating a positive attitude in all aspects of coaching the team.

He/she should be safety conscious and knowledgeable about handling sports injuries. He/she should also possess organizational skills needed to ensure appropriate use of practice time.

Responsibilities

- Be directly responsible to the Head Coach.
- Assist coach in communicating with both parents and players.
- Be punctual to all games and practices.
- Be responsible for the care and maintenance of all supplied equipment.
- Always be neat in your dress and at no time use tobacco or alcohol in any form in the presence of your athletes.
