Women's Wednesday Morning Bible Study (September 6 - November 15, 2023, Wednesday mornings 9:15-11:15 A.M.)

Abide: A Study of 1, 2, and 3 John, by Jen Wilkin. In three short letters, the apostle John reminds the early church facing division, deception, and doubt to instead hold fast to what they know and to live like they believe it. This 10-week Bible study will help you see 2,000 years later the call to Christians in similar challenges to an assurance of salvation and to abide in God's Truth.
