### **Applying the Gospel to Daily Life**

What blessings do we gain through faith in Jesus Christ? Are the blessings solely for the next life? Once I'm a Christian, should the gospel have any impact on my daily life? Join us for this six-week course as we work together on a growing understanding of the gospel that connects to our present daily lives. We will look at some very practical ways the gospel helps us to see and overcome our sin internally and in relationships with others. As God increases our awareness of the chasm between His holiness and our sinfulness, an ever-expanding understanding of the cross becomes essential for living a faithful and fruitful life in Christ.
