Scripture and Our Sanctification

The Bible is God's revelation of Himself and the gospel; it is also a primary means of saving and maturing His people. It contains a record of His activities in redemptive history and reveals what He will do in the future. Our six-week class will study what the Bible is, how to read it wisely, and how God uses it to change us. You will grow in your appreciation for the Bible, your confidence in reading and applying it, and your eagerness for how it will sanctify you more into the image of Jesus. This class is taught by Pastor Kelly Wright.
