### **Culture, Identity, and the Gospel: Rethinking Race and Belonging**

Does God see Color? Yes, but not in the way you might think.

Many assume that cultural identity is fixed, but the Bible presents a more dynamic view—one where cultural identity is malleable, shaped by interaction with other peoples, and ultimately reframed by the gospel.

In Class 1 of our two-week series, we'll explore how Scripture demonstrates this flexibility, with the gospel not only allowing but propelling cultural adaptation. In Class 2, we'll contrast this biblical vision with modern racialized thinking, which rigidly ties identity to skin color, and examine how this shapes our cross-cultural relationships.

Together, we'll consider how embracing cultural flexibility can help us live more faithfully as God's people in an increasingly diverse world.
