## Adult Bible Classes

Please see class descriptions of Adult Bible Classes below. All are welcome! Classes begin at **9:00 A.M.**; plan to arrive early to get kids checked-in on time.

### **Humanity: Beautifully and Wonderfully Made Divine Image Bearers**

In this 8-week Bible class we will study humanity—our origins, purpose, and destiny. We will consider what it means for us to bear God's image, how sin has affected our image bearing, and how redemption restores our ability to bear His image. We will also see how God's revelation about humanity stands in stark contrast to our culture's narrative. This class is taught by Kelly Wright.

### **Chaos, Clarity, and Confidence: The Journey of the Church**

We are undertaking a brief study of the history of God's people. This class will help us better understand the Bible as we see how the clarity of the gospel impacts the fruitfulness of the church and how this has ebbed and flowed under God's sovereignty through time. Knowing the history of our spiritual family provides us with confidence in the trustworthiness of God's Word, our appreciation for the realities of living as Christians in a fallen world, and examples to us for being a faithful witness today. This class is taught by Adam Zoeller and Noah Debaun.
